



**Dr. Erzsébet Hajnalka Czakó**

Dr. Erzsébet Hajnalka Czakó graduated from Karl Marx University of Economics (now Corvinus University of Budapest or BCE) in 1986, and has worked here ever since. In 1991 she earned her university doctorate, and in 2002 a PhD degree; she has been a university professor at BCE since 1 September 2013. She has participated in scientific and professional in-service training at several foreign universities, including the Catholic University of Leuven (Belgium) and Harvard Business School (USA). She teaches, among others, international strategy and corporate economics, and her fields of research include competitiveness. She teaches in Hungarian and English, and has released numerous publications in these two languages. Between 1994-2001 she was deputy head and between 2001-2004 head of the Department of Corporate Economics, between 2003-2005 vice-dean of Corvinus Business School, and since 2005 the director of the Institute of Corporate Economics.
