

## István Boros



István Boros (64) graduated from the College of Foreign Trade in 1972. In 1992 he got the economist degree of CUB International Economic Relations. Between 1974 and 1986 he gained experience in foreign trade in Hungary and in the meanwhile he had been worked for the Hungarian trade office in Paris from 1981 until 1986. He was the Deputy CEO of Hungexpo Rt. between 1989 and 1995, he took part in the establishment and supervision of hungarian-foreign joint venture companies (Publicis Hungary, Szonda-Ipsos). He had been the managing director of Cegos Counselling and Training Ltd. from 1995 and from 2015 he is owner and CEO of the company, after it was conversioned into cPlc.

He was founder and vice president of the French-Hungarian Chamber of Commerce and Industry from 1991 until 1997 and president between 2007 and 2010. He was the chairman of the advisory board of Autonomia Foundation between 2002 and 2014. He has been member of the advisory board of the Budapest Festival Orchestra since 2009, and he was a member of the Board of Directors from 2004 until 2009 of Herendi Porcelánmanufaktúra Rt. He was honoured with officer class of the National Order of Merit (France) in 2006.
