Dr. Erzsébet Czakó (51) graduated from the Karl Marx University of Economics (current name: Corvinus University of Budapest) in 1986 and since the graduation she has been working for CUB. She earned the doctorate in 1991, the PhD in 2002 and she became a professor of Corvinus University of Budapest at 1st September 2013. She participated academic and professional trainings at many foreign universities, like the Catholic University of Leuven (Belgium) and the Harvard Business School (USA). Among her taught subjects are international strategies and business economics, her research fields of interest are contents of competitiveness. She teaches both in Hungarian and English, and published many articles in both languages. Between 1994 and 2001 she was the deputy head, from 2001 until 2004 she was the head of the Business Economics Department. Between 2003 and 2005 she was the vice dean of the Faculty of Business Administration of CUB. From 2005 she is the director of the Institute of Business Economics.
